“CR Neon Genesis Evangelion: Second Impact” is the evolutionary sequel to the hit product “CR Neon Genesis Evangelion” (cumulative sales of 120,000 units), a machine whose continuing popularity is based on its incorporation of characters from the megahit animated film “Neon Genesis Evangelion.”

“Second Impact” builds on the concept of the earlier machine but offers an even more dynamic expression of the world of “Neon Genesis Evangelion,” delivering new and fully animated story elements that faithfully recall many more of the famous scenes from the original film.
