The first Monster Hunter, an action video game from Capcom Co., Ltd., went on sale in 2004. Since then, the series has been developed for a diverse range of platforms and earned overwhelming support from many video game fans. A total of 21 million units* of this popular video game series have been sold to date.

This pachislot machine captures the essence of the original video game by allowing users to experience the life of a hunter as they encounter a wide variety of monsters. A brand new Monster Hunter world has been created by combining a game progression based around subjugating monsters and game functions like the Assist Replay Time (ART) system and bonuses—the most enjoyable elements of pachislot.
